PACE provides academic support in an informal study session led by upper-year Wolfpack athletes



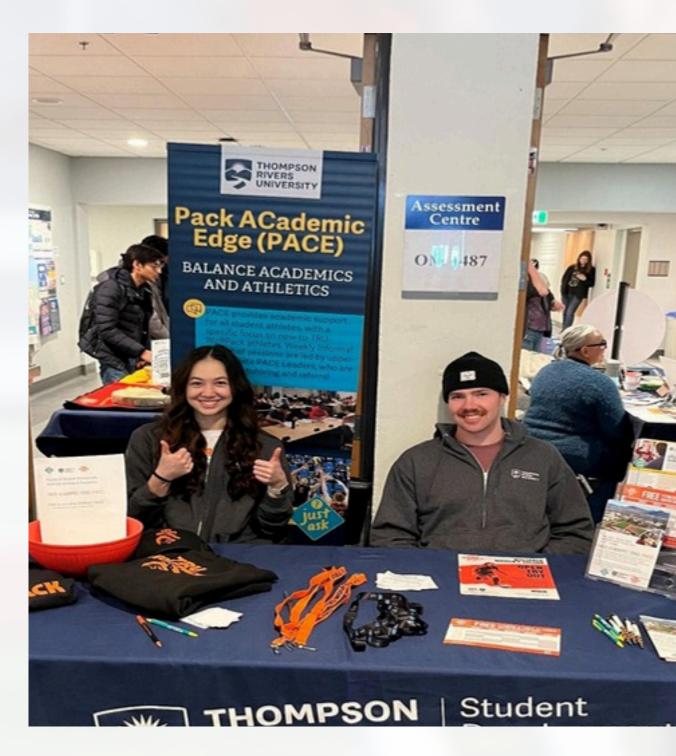

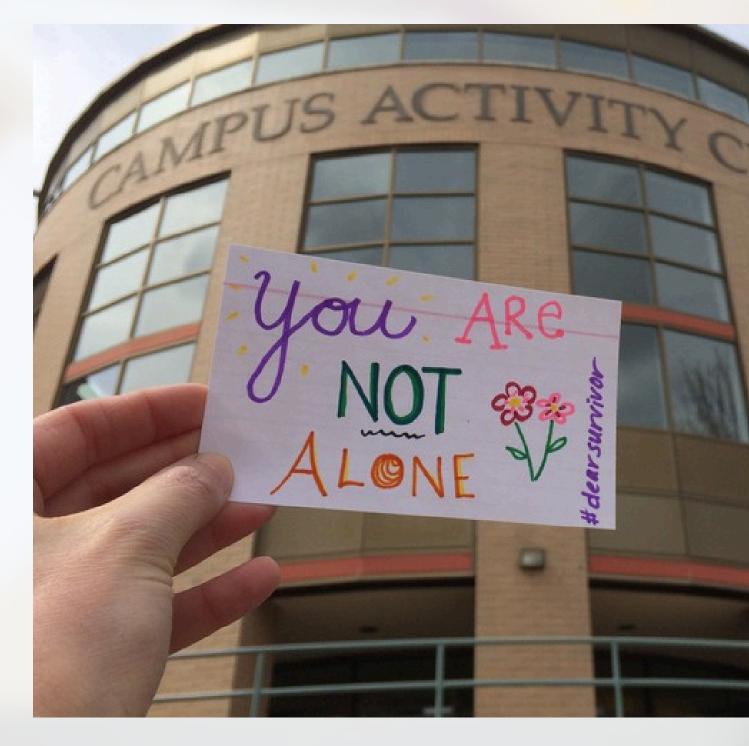

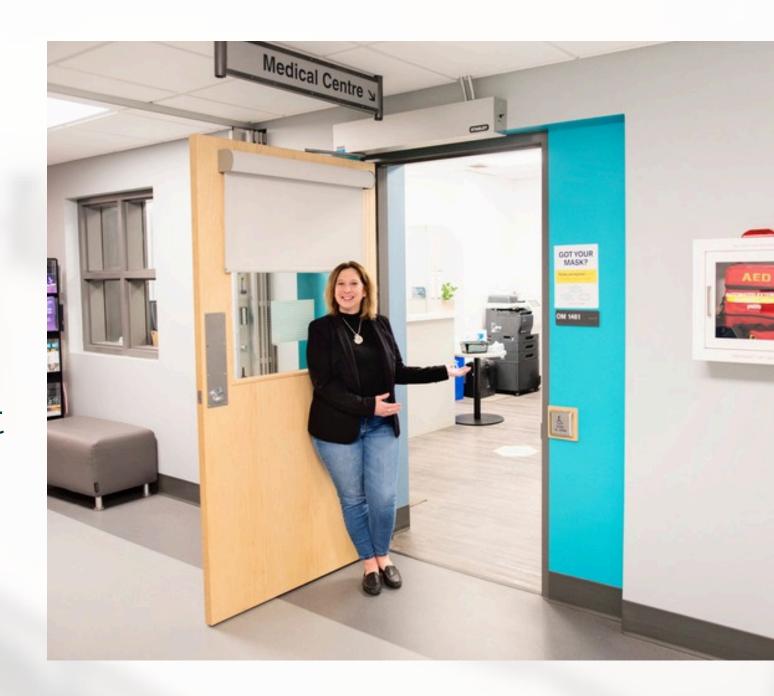
